We encourage you to bring lawn chairs for the service on the beach! The park has a large pavilion and bathrooms. For the picnic, the church is providing the main dish, drinks, and all the paper goods. We would like each family to bring either a side dish or dessert. There will be no refrigeration at the park; however, we will have trays of ice & there are a few outlets.

Directions: Lehmann Park is located in downtown Lake Villa. Go west on Grand, past rt. 83. After crossing the train tracks, turn right on Cedar Road. Before you cross the train tracks again, the park will be on your left .

Parking: Feel free to drop off your family at the park by the beach, get a parking sign for your window, & park at the Lake Villa Metra train station overflow lot next to the Lake Villa Post Office (on the other side of the train tracks).
