3 Core Principles:

∞ **God is at work**

- God is always at work to draw people to Himself
- He uses us to lead people to Him
- He invites us into the work of evangelism

∞ **Our natural pathways**

- God determines the exact places where we live and work. What would change if you believed Jesus sent you to your neighborhood, workplace, etc.
- Where are your natural pathways?

∞ **Believing my job description**

Practical tips:

∞ **7 ways to pray**

- Ask for revelation (Ephesians 1:17-19)
- Ask that God would “turn their eyes from worthless things” (Psalm 119:34-37)
- Ask that they “come to their senses” (2 Timothy 2:25-26)
- Ask God to send others to help (Matthew 9:38)
- Ask for an “open door for the message” (Colossians 4:2-4)
- Ask for boldness for you (Ephesians 6:18-20)
- Ask God to move quickly (2 Thessalonians 3:1)

☞ Gathering people

- Learn to do things “with people” and not “for people”
- Invite others into your day
- Enter into the interests of others

☞ Building relationships

- Take the lowest place
- Listen and remember
- Give your full attention
- Speak with joyful, encouraging words
- Develop a curious ear
 - *What question do you wish people would ask you about yourself?*

☞ 4 best questions to lead into spiritual conversations

- *What does your tradition say about Jesus?*
- *Do you consider yourself on a spiritual journey?*
- *I just learned something in the Bible that's really helping me deal with _____. May I share this with you?*
- *I'm in a fresh season of prayer. Do you have any prayer requests?*

☞ Skills to build

- Normalizing spiritual conversations
- Normalizing speaking about Scripture
- Normalizing sharing your stories of transformation
- Normalizing transitioning to a gospel presentation
